

City of Leoti Governing Body met in regular session Monday, October 1, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

President of Council Charlie Hughes asked City Clerk Cassandra King for Roll Call: Council members Levi Elder, Jody Crouch, Ken Farr, Kelma Burch, City Superintendent Juan Bocanegra, City Attorney Becky Faurot, City Treasurer Liz Gould and City Clerk Cassandra King. Absent: Mayor Cheryl Green. Also, in attendance was City Auditor Jim Kennedy.

Farr moved, Burch seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Crouch moved, Burch seconded to approve the consent agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Council President Hughes welcomed Jim Kennedy with Kennedy McKee & Company LLP Certified public accountants. Mr. Kennedy presented the annual audit report completed for 2017 fiscal year.

City Superintendent Juan Bocanegra answered questions on the Mayer report from the camera inspection of the sewers. Council discussed obtaining quotes for equipment that has been budgeted for 2019. Council discussed Council member Kelma Burch's finds as to the opinion of the Business owners on the trees and planters in front of each individual business. Elder motioned for City Superintendent to remove trees as needed and to trim up remaining tress so that they do not impede traffic or line of sight, seconded by Farr. Motion carried unanimously.

Code enforcement report presented clarified the purchase of roll up garage doors from September 17, 2018 meeting. Council, City Superintendent and City Clerk felt that insolated double doors, in place of a roll up garage door would be more cost effective, maintenance, and user friendly for the animal shelter. Crouch motioned to buy two metal swing doors for the animal shelter in place of roll up garage doors, seconded by Elder. Motion carried unanimously.

Cassandra King requested approval for City Clerk and Deputy Clerk Cendy Morcillo to attend Kansas/IIMC Conference in Wichita, KS November 12-16 2018 to attend required classes. Motion made by Crouch and seconded by Burch. For both City Clerk Cassy King and Deputy Clerk Cendy Morcillo to both attend Annual Fall Clerks Conference. Motion carried unanimously.

Crouch moved, Burch seconded, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 28-1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEOTI REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LEOTI, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE *STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE* FOR KANSAS CITIES, EDITION OF 2018, WITH CERTAIN OMISSIONS, CHANGES, AND ADDITIONS PRESCRIBING ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS; AND AMENDING SECTION 20-1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEOTI REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LEOTI, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE *UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES*, EDITION OF 2018, WITH CERTAIN AMENDMENTS OR OMISSIONS.

Discussion of the downtown trees and planter, Motion was made by Elder seconded by Farr to remove all dead trees downtown and to remove or trim up as needed and keep the planters. Motion carried unanimously.

Crouch moved, Elder seconded to recess into executive session pursuant to the nonelected personnel matters exception, K.S.A.75-4319(b)(1), to discuss a matter involving a city employee for 5 minutes with Council , Attorney, and City Clerk. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting resumed at 8:25 p.m. Hughes declared no action taken.

Hughes moved, Crouch seconded for adjournment at 8:38 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
