

City of Leoti Governing Body met in regular session Monday, December 3, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

Mayor Green called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m.

Mayor Green asked City Clerk Cassandra King for Role Call; Mayor Cheryl Green, President of Council Charlie Hughes. Councilors Kelma Burch, Jody Crouch, Ken Farr. City Attorney Becky Faurot, City Superintendent Juan Bocanegra and City Clerk Cassandra King were present. Absent was Levi Elder Also in attendance were Bruce Bangerter, and Dale Appl.

Farr moved, Burch seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Crouch moved, Farr seconded to approve the consent agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Council reviewed City Superintendent Bocanegra gave a verbal report. Bocanegra looked at the John Deer mower used 75hrs 3 year warranty for \$ 4,200.00 dollars was only use at John Deer for demos and grounds care. Motion made by Crouch to purchase mower at the first of the year as was budgeted for 2019, seconded by Kelma Burch Motion carried unanimously. Bocanegra check with Harkness welding on a welder for the Shop cost was \$200.00 more, but it is keeping our business local and it is a well-known name brand product. Motion made by Hughes to purchase the welder from Harkness Welding for \$ 3,000 including tanks, seconded by Crouch. Motion carried unanimously.

City Attorney Becky Faurot is working on the 2018 International Building Code amendment preparing for Council to review and adopt the updated version.

Code Enforcement written report was review with no questions.

City Clerk gave verbal report. EBH Engineering was coming out the following week to score the streets and dirt roads. Andrew Brunner will have a report and his recommendation for council on where to start for our plan to address the City's infrastructure.

Mayor Green opens the floor for public comments. Bruce Bangerter expressed his Thoughts of opening 5<sup>th</sup> Street and that 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Street should be opened. Mayor advised that we would look into some other things and will table the discussion to the next council meeting. Dale Appl expressed he was disappointed to the fact, that his letter was not responded to or answer. Council moved on, as there were no further comments.

Council discussed possible dates as to when they will have a work session. Mayor advised the council to check their upcoming schedules.

As there was no further business Crouch, motion to adjourn land Burch Second. Adjournment was at 8:15p.m.
