

AN ORDINANCE

ALLOWING CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AT SPECIFIC LOCATION ON JULY 4, 2017 FROM 6:30 to 10:30 p.m..

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 41-719(c) prohibits consumption of alcoholic liquor on public property;

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 41-719 (e) allows any county to exempt, by ordinance, from the provisions of subsection (c) specified property the title of which is vested in such county;

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 41-719(a)(2) allows alcoholic liquor to be consumed at a special event held on public streets, alleys, roads, sidewalks, or highways when a temporary permit has been issued pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2645; AND K.S.A. 41-2645 (e) allows cities to grant such a temporary permit by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Leoti desires to promote community celebration to thank the volunteers for their clean-up efforts following the April 29th, 2017 blizzard at Wichita County Park, 701 S. 5th Street, Leoti, Kansas.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the City of Leoti, Kansas:

1. The written request by Wichita Economic Development for a special event held Wichita County Park on July 4, 2017 from 6:30 to 10:30 p.m. is hereby approved.
2. This Ordinance is conditional upon County exemption pursuant to K.S.A. 41-719(e).
3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2645 (e), a temporary permit for the consumption of alcoholic beverages is granted for the following public streets, alleys, roads, sidewalks, or highways: streets surrounding Wichita County Park from 6:30 to 10:30 p.m. on July 4, 2017.
4. Provided however, that such street, alley, road, sidewalk or highway is to be closed to motor vehicle traffic by the governing body during such time.
5. The boundaries of the special event shall be clearly marked by signs identifying the area in which alcoholic liquor may be possessed or consumed at such special event.
6. No drinking will be allowed in vehicles. Attendees shall abide by all laws of the city and state.
