

City of Leoti Governing Body met in regular session Monday, July 20, 2026 at 6:30 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

Mayor Chris Kreutzer called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.

Mayor Kreutzer asked City Clerk Jeannine Hassell for Roll Call; Council President Derek Meyer, Councilors Kelma Burch, Rick Griem, Aron White and Jim Kreutzer. Also present were City Attorney Charles Moser and City Treasurer Liz Gould. City Superintendent Blaine Medina was absent.

Mayor Kreutzer opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Burch moved J. Kreutzer seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

The Consent Agenda items included: a. July 6, 2026 Regular Meeting Minutes, b. Payroll warrants \$20,813.67, c. Accounts Payable warrants \$35,937.16, d. Accounts Payable warrants \$19,460.05. (The warrants were available for review).

J. Kreutzer moved Meyer seconded to approve the consent agenda items a-d. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Kreutzer opened the floor for public comments. There were no comments.

Discussion was held on the City grant writer billing error.

J. Kreutzer moved Griem seconded to forgive the billing error of \$1300 and to draw up a new contract for the city grant writer. Motion carried 4 yeas, 1 nay (White).

Meyer moved Griem seconded to approve Ordinance 2026-10 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 28-1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEOTI REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LEOTI, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE *STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE* FOR KANSAS CITIES, 53RD EDITION OF 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

White moved Burch seconded to approve payment to Lewis, Hooper & Dick for final billing for 2025 Audit - \$3416.00. Motion carried unanimously.

White moved Meyer seconded to approve payment to Lewis, Hooper & Dick for final billing for 2027 budget preparation - \$5061.00 Motion carried unanimously.

White moved Meyer seconded to approve payment to Luna Construction for BCBS Pathways sidewalk replacement - \$9357.55. Motion carried unanimously.

City Attorney Moser had nothing new to share at this time.

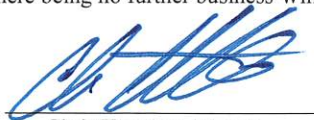
City Treasurer Gould provided February through May's treasurer reports and the budget authority report as of July 17, 2026. Gould shared that the new software system has made it difficult to reconcile. Since moving back to the old software system we were able to get caught up.

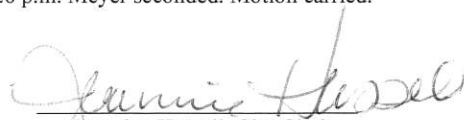
City Superintendent Blaine Medina provided a written report. The high service pump at the treatment plant will be serviced soon by JCI Pump Specialist. The parking stripes were painted on the south Highway 25. Luna Construction replaced sidewalks, west of the Economic Development office and just east of Midwest Energy office. These two sidewalks finished out the BCBS Pathways Project. B & H Paving will start chip sealing the northeast quadrant on Thursday, the 23rd of July. The city crew will be delivering trash cans and dumpsters for the upcoming fair festivities. On Friday the 31st the city crew will work until noon to complete the trash route.

City Clerk Hassell shared that city hall will be closed on July 31, Fair Friday and city shop will work until noon.

The next regular city council meeting is on Monday, August 3, 2026 at 6:30 pm.

There being no further business White made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:26 p.m. Meyer seconded. Motion carried.
