

City of Leoti Governing Body met in regular session Tuesday, September 3, 2024 at 6:30 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

Mayor Chris Kreutzer called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

Mayor Kreutzer asked Deputy City Clerk Cendy Morcillo for Roll Call; Council President Derek Meyer, Councilors Kelma Burch, Aron White and Jim Kreutzer. Also present were City Attorney Charles Moser, City Superintendent Blaine Medina and City Treasurer Liz Gould. City Clerk Jeannine Hassell and City Councilor Greg Graff were absent.

Council President Derek Meyer entered the meeting at 6:35 p.m.

Mayor Kreutzer opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

White moved J. Kreutzer seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

The Consent Agenda items included: a. August 19, 2024 Regular Meeting Minutes, b. Payroll warrants \$31,150.41, c. Accounts Payable warrants \$165,438.73. Council President Derek Meyer reviewed and signed the accounts payable warrant book dated September 3, 2024.

Meyer moved J. Kreutzer seconded for the approval of 2024 Earl Street Project Pay Estimate No. 4 for the total of \$133,722.60. Motion carried unanimously.

Council reviewed City Superintendent's report.
