

City of Leoti Governing Body met in regular session on Monday, December 7, 2020 at 6:30 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

Mayor Charlie Hughes called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Hughes asked City Clerk Hassell for the Role Call; Council President Levi Elder, Council members: Kelma Burch, Jody Crouch and City Superintendent Travis Seaton. Also in attendance were Greg Graff (Zoom), Kris Casper, Lynda Goodrich, Cole Carpenter Randy Keeton Carter Berning and Wayne Scofield. City Attorney Becky Faurot and Councilor Tammie Meyers-Divens were absent.

Mayor Hughes opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

City council will make a decision at the next meeting on December 21, 2020.

Mayor Hughes welcomed Randy Keeton, Kris Casper and Carter Berning. Keeton, Casper and Berning shared information with council about a possible sport shooting range. Discussions were held on a location, insurance, rules and regulations. The discussion was tabled until more information can be gathered.

Carter Berning asked council for permission to take out a section of curbing on Carter Street to make a level concrete driveway entry to his property. Berning will pay for all expenses. Council will give a final decision after visiting with City Attorney Faurot.

Carter Berning left the meeting at 7:21 pm.




Mayor Hughes opened the floor to public comments. There were no public comments.
