

City of Leoti Governing Body met in regular session on Monday, November 16, 2020 at 6:30 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

Mayor Charlie Hughes called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Hughes asked City Clerk Hassell for the Role Call; Council President Levi Elder (Zoom), Council members: Kelma Burch, Jody Crouch, Tammie Meyer-Givens, City Superintendent Travis Seaton and City Attorney Becky Faurot (Zoom). Also in attendance were Greg Graff, Judith Lemus, Nikki Bjurstrom (Zoom) and Darla Lewis (Zoom).
